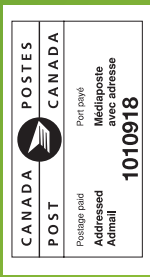

FALL WINTER SPRING DRAMA CLASSES

DRAMA CLASSES GRADES JK - 12

Limited to 16 students per class

Our professional arts educators lead dynamic classes teaching drama skills tailored to each student's age and abilities. Our curriculum includes basic story-telling and cooperative games, character development, improvisation, and scene-building. Social and cognitive skills are engaged throughout all theatre, movement, vocal and physical exercises. At each level, students develop confidence in their own creative voice while learning how to work collaboratively.

THE AUDITION GRADES 7 - 8

Limited to 12 students
Recommended: Previous YPT classes or equivalent

If you are auditioning for an arts school or show, this is the class to take! Students learn the strategies and skills necessary to bring their monologue to life, and how to make the best impression from the first step into the room to the final goodbye.

THE JUNIOR ENSEMBLE GRADES 7 - 8

Limited to 12 students
Admission by audition: In order to be scheduled for the December audition, please complete the registration form.

This comprehensive program is designed for students who demonstrate readiness for more advanced theatre training. Students will spend five months creating a cohesive ensemble and devising their own new play, which will be performed twice to an invited audience at the end of the program.

EXTREME THEATRE GRADES 9 - 12

Limited to 16 students
Required: Previous YPT classes or equivalent

For those students who are seeking a challenge and wish to hone their stagecraft, this advanced class offers more rigorous training in all the skills an actor needs. Extreme Theatre is an excellent pre-cursor to The Senior Ensemble.

WRITERS' BLOC NEW! GRADES 7 - 12

October 2013 - April 2014

Theatre for youth by youth! Our new playwriting unit, Writers' Bloc, runs weekly from October through April, during which time students learn numerous script-building skills while working with text from a variety of playwrights. In the second half of the program, each student chooses one idea to develop to completion - be it a scene, a one-act play, a film script or a form of their choice. In April, the last two classes dovetail with final classes of The Senior Ensemble wherein members perform a reading of the Writers' Bloc playwrights' final pieces.

THE SENIOR ENSEMBLE GRADES 9 - 12

Our most advanced theatre class is for dedicated students looking to challenge themselves within an intensive 8-week program. Using the text from a significant play chosen by the instructor, a select group of students investigate acting in the context of a particular performance element, such as personal history, social conditions, and artistic style. This year, the Senior Ensemble also connects with our new playwriting unit, Writers' Bloc. The Senior Ensemble members put their newly-honed skills to work through the rehearsal and performance of a reading of the Writers' Bloc's final pieces.
