

Content Advisory – *Selfie*

We want to help you make the best possible decision when determining whether a play is right for the young people in your life. To that end we have provided suggested age ranges, content information and educational resources. Ultimately though, these recommendations are only estimates. They cannot take into account the individual development and maturation of each young person. You know the young people in your life best.

Selfie is about the complex, sometimes confusing world of teenage friendships and romantic relationships. The language and situations depicted in the play are reflective of the mature subject matter it explores. Audience members should be advised that the play looks honestly at the nature of sexual consent. In the course of the story, the characters speak about and reflect upon a rape that is not depicted but nevertheless occurs.

They speak in authentic teenage voices, using explicit language including swearing throughout the play. There are also scenes in which they are drinking at a party.
